Professional Charter of the Water Jetting Association

All Members of the Association and their employees agree to adopt and abide by this Charter incorporating the following principles:

DECLARATION

1. Legality & Fairness:

Members will ensure that they conduct themselves and their business in a legal, lawful and socially responsible manner and that they uphold principles of fairness and equal opportunity and business practices which are free from any form of unlawful discrimination whether on the grounds of age, sex, race, disability or otherwise.

2. Competence & Professional Standards:

Members will guarantee that all business affairs are administered in a thoroughly competent and professional manner.

3. Honesty & Integrity:

Members will adopt an attitude in all business relationships which is totally honest, diligent and faithful as regards not only all contracts or agreements into which you enter freely but also any other business arrangements and obligations.

4. No Prejudicial Action:

Members will refrain from any conduct or action that is prejudicial or detrimental to the interests of The Water Jetting Association (WJA) and will not act in any manner which is likely to bring themselves, their profession or the WJA into disrepute.

5. Active Participation:

Members will undertake to become active participants within The Water Jetting Association, accept all the rules and promote them within their organisation and agree to support all common objectives.

6. Compliance:

- a) Members undertake that any work which they perform will be carried out according to the requirements of the relevant Code of Practice published by The Water Jetting Association.
- b) Members will sign a declaration at each Annual Membership Renewal date confirming that they are fully insured and covered for all activities of their business.
- c) Members will confirm acceptance of this Charter annually by signing a copy and returning to the WJA with the Membership Renewal.

7. Accidents, Incidents & Near Misses:

All Accidents, Incidents and Near Misses must be reported to the WJA (can be made anonymously) for inclusion on the WJA Website (Incidents Section).

8. Expulsion for Breach

Any breach of this Charter by members will be dealt with in accordance with the Constitution and Byelaws of the WJA and may lead to expulsion from the WJA.
